

## Collaboration in Education Award – Nomination Form

- 2. Effectively integrating learners into the team
- 3. Providing opportunities for learners to engage in interprofessional practice and education
- 4. Role modeling the competencies for interprofessional collaboration (e.g. role clarification, communication, collaborative leadership, patient-centred care)

A strong nomination provides examples of these behaviours in all 4 areas.
